## **STUDENT DAY REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS**

**1. Event Format:** Students may complete a live or video audition. The written theory and aural tests are available two ways.

**A. Online theory testing** – Follow the instructions found here to register each student for the online tests. <https://www.fmta.org/fsmta-non-competitive-events.html>. Tests should be completed before May 2<sup>nd</sup>. Failure to complete before May 2<sup>nd</sup> will delay certificates.

**B. In-person testing** – The written theory exam will be available throughout the day. Aural theory exams will be scheduled between 8:00-9:00, 12:00-1:00, 4:00-5:00. When possible, students using in-person testing will be scheduled to complete their playing audition within 2 hours of their testing time. Teachers using the in-person testing should plan to help administer these tests. More information about scheduling will be sent to those who choose in-person testing.

**2. Registration Form:** Each teacher should complete and submit one copy of the registration form either by physical copy, email, or via the Google Spreadsheet Registration Form. A copy of the master list, including all audition times will be sent (via email) to each participating teacher. Please let the chairman know if you do not have access to a computer and a paper copy will be mailed to you. Be certain to double-check all spellings so they will be correct on the certificates. There is a place on the registration form to select the times you are available to work. Pick up locations for completed certificates and medals can also be selected on the registration form. **The registration form is due no later than April 11<sup>th</sup>.**

**3. Student Day Examination Form:** One Student Day Examination Form must be completed for each student entered. Interactive versions of these forms can be downloaded from the FSMTA Website <https://www.fmta.org/fsmta-non-competitive-events.html>. The 2025-2026 password is "Music". Completed forms may be mailed or submitted by email [dpianosings@yahoo.com](mailto:dpianosings@yahoo.com). These forms are **due no later than April 17<sup>th</sup>.**

Remember, we must comply with Florida State Repertoire Requirements which mandate that all pieces must be original compositions rather than simplified classical pieces. However, one hymn arrangement per entry is allowed. No photocopies are allowed. Please provide separate original copies for the soloist, accompanist, and judge.

**3. Special Scheduling Requests:** The last column is for Special Scheduling Requests. We will do everything we can to honor these special requests. Please also indicate in this column if the student will be doing a live or video audition. A link for uploading video auditions will be sent to you.

**4. Check:** Include your payment for entry fees and teacher fee. Cost is \$30 per student for each instrument entered. The teacher fee is \$10 which includes lunch. Send one check per teacher, made out to PMTA, for the combined total of entry fees and your \$10 teacher fee. **Due no later than April 17<sup>th</sup>.**
